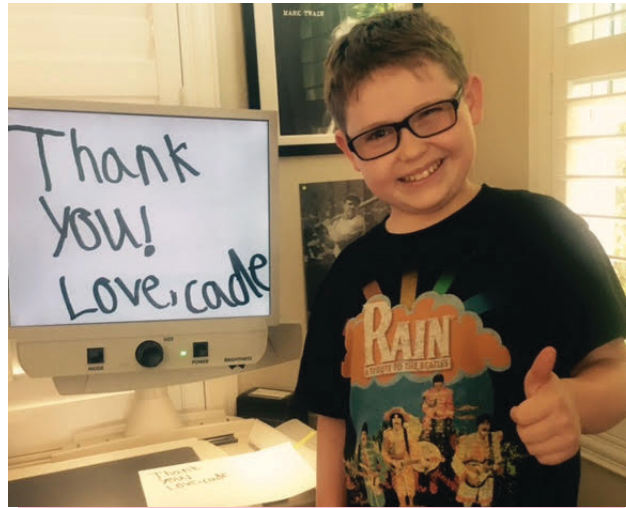


ABOUT US
