JANUARY 12 - Sleep Disorders in children with low vision/blindness - Dr. Bill will speak to parents about sleep disturbances and how best to help their child work through these issues.

FEBRUARY 9 - Feeding concerns in children with low vision/blindness - Dr. Bill will help parents with strategies to assist their children with feeding issues.

MARCH 9 - Optic Nerve Hypoplasia - Dr. Bill will review the diagnosis of ONH and assist parents in understanding the diagnosis as well as providing strategies to assist your child with specific issues associated with ONH.

APRIL 13 - Color Blindness in Children - Dr. Bill will go over the diagnosis of color blindness and how it may affect the overall vision of a child.

SEPTEMBER 14 - Children Slowly Losing Vision - Dr. Bill will describe how a child slowly losing vision may impact their development and give strategies to assist parents.

OCTOBER 12 - Toys for Children with Low and No Vision - Dr. Bill and the Consultants will provide suggestions for toys and activities for children with low vision or blindness.

NOVEMBER 9 - Cortical Visual Impairment - Dr. Bill will discuss CVI and the specific challenges and strategies to help your child with their vision.
